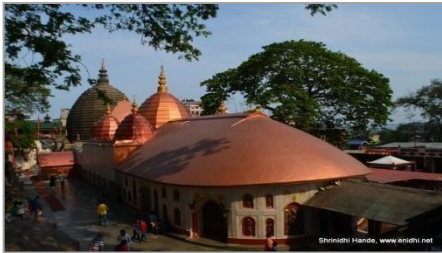
Three Sisters Package

Assam

Dominated by the mighty Brahmaputra River, the state of Assam is the gateway to the northeastern part of India. Endowed with lush greenery, Assam India is renowned for Assam tea, silk, petroleum resources and rich flora and fauna, the world famous one horned rhinoceros and other rare species of wildlife on the verge of extinction. The dense forests of Assam are home to numerous animals and birds and one of the last wild habitats for the Asian elephants.

*Kaziranga National Park, *Brahmaputra River Cruise, *Kamakhya Devi Temple, *Nabagraha Temple, *Umananda Temple, *Basistha Temple, *Bihu Dance, are the major tourist attractions in Assam.



Arunachal Pradesh

Tawang, in Arunachal Pradesh, is the birthplace of the sixth Dalai Lama, Tsangyang Gyatso, an unconventional one known for his love of wine, women, and poetry. His poetry is widely read among Tibetans even today.

Also, Bum la pass, a little ahead, is where the current Dalai Lama, 14th in succession, entered India, escaping from Tibet.

*Madhuri Lake, *Bum La Pass, Sela Pass, *Jaswantgarh, *Tawang Monastery, *Kiwi Orchids & *Light & Sound show at War Memorial, are the major tourist attractions in Arunachal Pradesh.



Meghalaya

Meghalaya is one of the most visited destination of north east, because of the diversity of natural aesthetic bounty here. It is considered the hotspot of all things cultural and natural existing in sheer harmony with the constructive human efforts. To date, it remains one of those rare locations that can be visited all year round and still over compensate every travellers thirst for a fulfilling retreat.

*Mawlynnong Village, *Double Decker Living Root Bridge, *Don Bosco Museum, *Uiam Lake, *Mawmai Cave, *Elephant Falls, are the major tourist attractions in Meghalaya.

Assam, Arunachal Pradesh & Meghalaya



Day 1: Guwahati – Shillong

Departure for Guwahati by flight, Guwahati arrival and proceed to Shillong (100km), after refreshment, Shillong local sightseeing (Umiam Lake, Wards Lake) and free time and Shillong halt.

Day 2: Shillong

After breakfast, proceed to Cherapunji and Cherapunji local sightseeing (Shillong Top, Mawsmi Caves, Seven Sister Falls, NohKaLikai Falls, Koh Ramah etc.) After lunch, Thangkharang Park visit and return to Shillong and halt.



Day 3: Shillong

After breakfast, proceed to Dawki (Bangladesh Border) Boat rider in the cleanest river and return to Shillong and halt. (by Mawlynnong & Root Bridge visit)

Day 4: Shillong – Tezpur

After breakfast, departure Shillong for Tezpur, (Tezpur is famous city for ancient cities and temples.



Day 5: Tezpur – Dirnag

After breakfast, departure Tezpur for Dirang, Dirang arrival at evening and halt

Day 6: Dirnag – Tawang

After breakfast, departure Dirang for Tawang via Sela Lake visit, Tawang arrival and halt. (Evening visit to Tawang Monastery)

Day 7: Tawang

After breakfast, Full day Tawang local sightseeing (Bumla Pass, Madhuri Lake, Pekong Teng Lake which is near to China Border) and Tawang halt.



Day 8: Dirang

After breakfast, departure Tawang for Dirang via Orchid garden visit. Dirang arrival at evening and halt.

Day 9: Kaziranga

After breakfast, proceed to Kaziranga from Dirang, Kaziranga arrival at evening and halt. (Assami cultural Folk

dance programme at evening)



Day 10: Kaziranga - Guwahati

Kaziranga National Park Elephant /Jeep safari at early in the morning and proceed to Guwahati and halt. (Evening free time for Bramhaputra River Cruise ride)

Day 11:Guwahati:

After breakfast, Guwahati local sightseeing (Kamakhya Temple, Umananda Temple etc.) and Guwahati halt. (Evening free time for shopping)

Day 12: Return

After breakfast proceed to Guwahati air port, departure Guwahati by flight & tour end.(Hotel checkout time 12Noon)

Tour Includes:-

1. Accommodation – We provide super deluxe category hotels on twin sharing basis.
2. Transport – Guwahati airport pickup to Guwahati airport drop with covering all cities and sightseeing by comfortable A/C Tempo Traveller.
