THE BHUTAN: - THE LAND OF THUNDER DRAGONS



Introduction: - Bhutan is a landlocked country in South Asia settled between two powerful neighbors, China and India. Bhutan is mostly mountainous and controls several key Himalayan mountain passes. The government system is a constitutional monarchy; the chief of state is the king, and the head of government is the prime minister. Bhutan has a largely traditional economic system in which the allocation of available resources is made on the basis of inheritance and primitive methods.

Bhutan Tour Itinerary: - 8 days Best Tour Package



Day 1:- Bagdogra – Phuntsholing

Tour Guests will arrive at Bagdogra Airport as per their Scheduled flight.

Upon arrival they will meet our manager at the airport and proceed to

Phuntsholing – the gateway to Bhutan.

Day 2:- Phuntsholing to Thimphu

Today we proceed to Thimphu. En-route we visit Kharbandi Gompa – built by the Royal Grandmother as her winter residence. Upon arrival, we have free time for relaxing and exploring the surroundings.





Day 3:- Thimphu Today we explore Thimphu city, we visit Motithang mini zoo – a wildlife reserve area for 'Takin' the national animal of Bhutan, Buddha Dordenma Statue, Chang Gangkha, Tashichho Dzong, National Library and Handicraft Center.

Day 4:- Thimphu – Punakha Today en-route to Punakha we visit Dochula pass and 108 memorial chortens also known as Druk Wangyal Chorten. Later we proceed to the low lands on Punakha valley. Upon arrival, we visit famous Punakha Dzong - the second oldest and second largest Dzong in Bhutan, followed by a thrilling experience of white water rafting in the Punakha River.



Day 5:- Punakha – Paro

Today we proceed to Paro. Upon arrival, we view Drukgyel Dzong – a Victory Fortress. Later we visit Paro Dzong, Ta-Dzong also known as National Museum and Kyichu Lhakhang – one of the oldest and most sacred shrines in Bhutan.



Day 6:- Paro to Lataguri Lataguri is located outside the [Gorumara National Park](#) on National Highway No. 31. Permits for entering [Gorumara](#) and [Chapramari Wildlife Sanctuary](#) are given from Lataguri. The village also contains a "Nature Interpretation Center", which gives information about the [flora](#) and [fauna](#) of the area.

Day 7:- lataguri to siliguri from lataguri we are heading to siliguri breakfast will be in-between them.

Day 8:- Drop to Airport

The great journey of Bhutan is going to end here.
