INTRODUCTION: - New Delhi is the capital city of India. As the national capital, New Delhi is the seat of executive, legislative, and judiciary branches of the Government of India. It also serves as the centre of the Government of the National Capital Territory of Delhi. Mathura is situated on the banks of the Yamuna River; Mathura is a sacred town for the Hindus that has found mention in historical and mythological anecdotes. Mathura city is mentioned in the oldest epic, the Ramayana. It was first known as Madhuvan because of the thick and dense forests that were once there.

Best Tour Package

Day 1: - The trip will start from Pune by Jhelum Express (11077) at 5.20 p.m. towards Agra (Train Journey).



Day 2: - Arrival at Agra 5.00 p.m. and shifted to hotel to get fresh. Overnight stay at Agra. The name Agra is explained by different derivations, all of which have low verifiability. The most accepted one is that it had its origin from the Hindi word *agar* meaning salt-pan, a name which was given to it because the soil in the region is brackish and salt used to be made here once by evaporation.

Day 3: - After breakfast, Agra local sightseeing like Taj Mahal one of the great wonders, Agra Fort a great architecture and Fatehpur Sikri. Return to Agra and overnight stay at Agra.



Day 4: - After breakfast, Proceed to Delhi via Mathura and Vrindavan darshan. Overnight stay at Delhi. Vrindavan is a holy town in Uttar Pradesh, northern India. The Hindu deity Krishna is said to have spent his childhood here. Its home to temples, many dedicated to Krishna and his lover, the deity Radha.

Day 5: - After breakfast Delhi local sightseeing like India Gate, Lotus Temple, Red Fort, Akshar Dham, Jama Masjid, Rashtrapati Bhavan, Qutub Minar, Chandni Chowk Etc.



Day 6: - After breakfast local sightseeing and cultural visits. The India Gate is a war memorial located astride the Rajpath on the eastern edge of the "ceremonial axis" of New Delhi, formerly called duty path. The Red Fort or Lal Qila is a historic fort in Old Delhi, Delhi in India that served as the main residence of the

Mughal Emperors.

Day 7: - Leaving Delhi early in the morning for Haridwar at 6.45 a.m. by Dehradun Shatabdi Express (12017). Dehradun arrival at 11.22 a.m. After getting fresh Haridwar local sightseeing Maa Chandi Devi Mandir, Shri Mata Mansa Devi Mandir Etc.



Day 8: - After breakfast, Proceed to Rishikesh darshan. Local sightseen in Rishikesh and return to Haridwar. Overnight stay at Haridwar.



Day 9: - Leaving Haridwar early in the morning at 6.25 a.m. by

Janashatabdi Express (12056). Delhi arrival at 11.15 and proceed for Pune at 3.00 p.m. by Goa Express (12780)

Day 10: - Pune arrival at 4.35 p.m. Tour ends.
