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## LEH – KARGIL – PANGONG – NUBRA TOUR (10 DAYS)



Introduction: Leh was an important stopover on trade routes along the Indus Valley between Tibet to the east, Kashmir to the west and also between India and China for centuries. Unlike other districts in India, the Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council (LAHDC) is in charge of governance in Leh. It has 30 councilors, 4 nominated and 26 elected. The Chief Executive Councilor heads and chairs this council. The Deputy Commissioner of Leh also holds the power of Chief Executive Officer of the LAHDC.

### BEST TOURPACKAGE

**Day 1:** - Departure Pune to Srinagar by flight and halt.  
(Only Dinner)



**Day 2:** - After breakfast, Proceed to Kargil from Srinagar and halt. Kargil is protected by the mighty Himalayas and fed by Karste river, Kargil is the most picturesque destination in Kashmir. Kargil became a site for the 1999 Indo-Pak war. Although, the invincible Indian Army won the war but victory came at a heavy cost. The ultimate sacrifice of brave soldiers who laid down their lives fighting against extreme weather conditions as well as enemy resistance was commemorated here at the memorial. (Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)



**Day 3:** - After breakfast, Departure Kargil and heading towards Leh. (The city of wonders) and halt. (Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

**Day 4:** - After breakfast, Full day local sightseeing in Leh like Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace, Thiksey Monastery, Sankar Gumpa, Leh Main Market, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib etc and halt.  
(Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)



**Day 5:** - After breakfast, Departure Leh for Pangong Lake and halt. After the mid-19th century, Pangong Tso was at the southern end of Johnson Line, an early attempt at demarcation between India and China in the Aksai Chin region. The Khurnak Fort lies on the northern bank of the lake, about halfway of Pangong Tso.

**Day 6:** - After breakfast, Departure Pangong Lake for Leh and halt. (Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

**Day 7:** - After breakfast, Departure Leh for Nubra and halt. Nubra, also called Dumra, is a historical region of Ladakh, India that is currently administered as a subdivision and a tehsil in the Leh district. Its inhabited areas form a tri-armed valley cut by the Nubra and Shyok rivers. Its Tibetan name Dumra means a "valley of flowers". (Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

**Day 8:** - After breakfast, Return to Leh from Nubra Valley and halt. (Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

**Day 9:** - After breakfast, Leh local sightseeing like Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace, Thiksey Monastery etc. and halt. (Tea, Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)



**Day 10:** - After breakfast, Proceed to Delhi from Leh by air and from Delhi Forward to Pune for further journey by flight. Tour ends. (Tea, Breakfast)
