**Introduction:** - Madhya Pradesh is the second largest Indian state by area and the fifth largest state by population with over 72 million residents. It borders the states of Uttar Pradesh to the northeast, Chhattisgarh to the east, Maharashtra to the south, Gujarat to the west, and Rajasthan to the northwest.

**Day 1:** - Journey will starts from Pune towards Indore by Train (Train Journey)





**Day 2:** - Indore arrival at 8.30 a.m. Shifted to the hotel to get fresh. After lunch Omkareshwar Darshan. **Omkareshwar** is a Hindu temple dedicated to Shiva, located in Mandhata, nearby Khandwa city in Khandwa district of the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. It is one of the 12 revered Jyotirlinga shrines of Shiva. centuries ago the Bhil tribe settled people on this place and now this

place is famous for its grandeur and history. It is on an island called Mandhata, near Khandwa city in the Narmada river at Khandwa district in Madhya Pradesh, India; the shape of the island is said to be like the Devanagari 3<sup>5</sup> symbol. Overnight at Indore.



**Day 3:** - After breakfast, proceed to Ujjain darshan. Ujjain is an ancient city beside the Kshipra River in the central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. An important Hindu pilgrimage destination, it's known for the centuries-old Mahakaleshwar Temple. Return to Indore. Overnight at Indore.

Day 4: - After breakfast, Leaving Indore for Mandavgad.

According to a Sanskrit inscription of 555 A.D, the History of Mandu goes back to the 6th century when it was a fortified city. It was later named Mandhavgarh in the 10th or 11th century, by the rulers of the Parmara kingdom. In the year 1261, even the capital of the Parmaras was transferred from Dhar to Mandu. Return to Indore. Overnight at Indore.





**Day 5:** - After breakfast, proceed to Bhopal. Bhopal arrival and stay in Bhopal. Bhopal is a city in the central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. It's one of India's greenest cities. There are two main lakes, the Upper Lake and the Lower Lake.

**Day 6:** - Bhopal local sightseeing like, Sanchi Stupa & Bhopal Lake .After lunch proceed for Panchmarhi. Pachmarhi, also known as Satpura ki Rani, is a hill station in the central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. Its many waterfalls include Apsara Vihar, with its calm pool, and soaring, single-drop Silver Fall nearby. Overnight stay at Panchmarhi





**Day 7:** - After breakfast, Panchmarhi local sightseeing like, Jatashankar Temple, Bee Falls, Shree Panch Pandav Caves, Apsara Vihar, Handi Khoh, Priyadarshini point, Dutchess Fall **Day 8:** - After breakfast, proceed for Kanha. Kanha arrival and stay at Kanha.





**Day 9:** - Kanha national park visit. Kanha National Park, also known as Kanha Tiger Reserve, is a vast expanse of grassland and forest in the central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. Tigers, jackals and wild pigs can be spotted in Kanha Meadows. The elevated plateau of Bamhnidadar is home to birds of prey. Animals often gather at the watering holes of Sondar Tank and Babathenga Tank.

Day 10: - After breakfast proceed for Jabalpur, Jabalpur arrival and local sightseeing in Jabalpur, Medhaghat. Balancing Rock, Bedhaghat and stay at Jabalpur.





**Day 11:** - After breakfast, proceed to Khajuraho. Arrival at Khajuraho and stay at Khajuraho. The Khajuraho Group of Monuments are a group of Hindu and Jain temples in Chhatarpur district, Madhya Pradesh, India, about 175 kilometres southeast of Jhansi. They are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The temples are famous for their nagara-style

architectural symbolism and a few erotic sculptures.

**Day 12:** - After breakfast Khajuraho local sightseeing like, Lakshmana Temple, Kandariya Mahadev Temple, Dulhadev Shiva Temple, Vishwanath Temple, Chaturbhuj Temple.





**Day 13:** - Leaving Khajuraho at early in the morning for Satana. Leaving Satana at 10.50 a.m. by Train. (Train journey)

Day 14: - Pune arrival at 8.05 a.m. tour ends.
