Introduction: - Rajasthan literally means "The Land of Kings". The Pratiharas ruled for many dynasties in this part of the country; the region was known as Gujarata. Jaipur, Udaipur, Bikaner are some important factors of Rajasthan. **Jaipur**, [city](#), capital of [Rajasthan](#) state, northwestern [India](#). It is situated in the east-central part of the state, roughly equidistant from [Alwar](#) (northeast) and [Ajmer](#) (southwest). It is Rajasthan's most-populous city.

Best Tour Package Itinerary:-



Day 1:- Proceed to Jaipur from Pune airport at afternoon & Shifted to hotel, after getting fresh, evening visit to Birla Temple Darshan, Overnight stay at Jaipur.

Day 2:- After breakfast, it will be a great day in Jaipur. We are going to see Hawa Mahal, Jantar Mantar, Nahargarh Fort, City Palace, and Amber Palace, Albert Hall Museum Etc. The day will end by having a great dinner. Overnight stay in Jaipur.



Day3:- Head towards the Bikaner by taking leave from Jaipur. Bikaner arrival. Bikaner is a city in the north Indian state of Rajasthan, east of the border with Pakistan. It's surrounded by the Thar Desert. The city is known for the 16th-century Junagarh Fort, a huge complex of ornate buildings and halls.

Day 4:- After breakfast local sightseeing in Bikaner. Junagarh Fort, Shree Laxminath Temple, The Laxmi Niwas Palace Etc. Are some places of tourist attraction in Bikaner. The Junagarh fort complex was built under the supervision of Karan Chand, the Prime Minister of Raja Rai Singh, the sixth ruler of Bikaner, who ruled from 1571 to 1611 AD. Construction of the walls and associated moat commenced in 1589 and was completed in 1594.



Day 5:- Proceed to Jaisalmer from Bikaner. Arrival at

Jaisalmer. Jaisalmer have various cultures and traditions and one of them is living in tents. So will enjoy a night in Jaisalmer's traditional and cultural Tents.



Day 6:- After having breakfast, Jaisalmer local sightseeing like Sonargarh , Gadisagar Lake, Thar Desert. Known as the "Golden City," it's distinguished by its yellow sandstone architecture, Bada Bagh Temple, Dessert Cultural Centre etc.



Day 7:- Heading towards Jodhpur by leaving Jaisalmer. Jodhpur arrival and Local sightseeing in Jodhpur. Mehrangarh Fort Museum, Umaid Bhavan Palace, Ghanta Ghar, Mandore Garden, etc.

Day 8:- Heading towards Pushkar from Jodhpur via Ajmer Darshan. Pushkar is a city and headquarters of Pushkar tehsil in the Ajmer district in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It is situated about 10 km northwest of Ajmer and about 150 kilometres southwest of Jaipur. It is a pilgrimage site for Hindus and Sikhs. Pushkar has many temples. Overnight in Pushkar.



Day 9:- Leaving Pushkar behind, Forwarding towards Chittorgarh.

Chittorgarh is a city and municipality in Rajasthan, northwest India. It's known for the honey-colored, 7th-century Chittorgarh Fort, a vast hilltop complex with the remains of many temples and monuments.. Shifted to Udaipur. Overnight stay at Udaipur.

Day 10:- Udaipur Local sightseeing. Udaipur, formerly the capital of the Mewar Kingdom. Puppet Show, Saheliyon ki Badi, City Palace, Motimagar ,etc.



Day 11:- Leaving Udaipur for Mount Abu via Rankapur Darshan. The town built was named Ranakpur, after the king, and the same town is now known as Ranakpur. The construction of the temple began in the 14th century and went on till the 15th century. There are a total of 5 temples in India that are considered the most sacred for Jain. One of them is Ranakpur Jain Temple. Overnight stay at Mount Abu.

Day 12:- Mount Abu Local sightseeing. Nakki Lake, Dilwada Temple, Adhar Devi Temple, etc. Mount Abu is a hill station in western India's Rajasthan state, near the Gujarat border. Set on a high rocky plateau in the Aravalli Range and surrounded by forest, it offers a relatively cool climate and views over the arid plains below.

Day 13:- Heading towards Ahmedabad via Ambaji darshan. Arrival at Ahmedabad. Leaving Ahmedabad for Pune by Air in evening at 7.00 p.m. Arriving Pune at 9.50 p.m. Tour ends.
